# TURF & TOO MUCH WATER

## **LARGE / BROWN PATCH**

This fungus is usually observed during the cooler months when the days are shorter and the turf does not dry out as fast as the summer months. It is easily identified as round or circle like patches as seen below.

# TURF & TOO MUCH WATER

## DOLLAR WEED & NUTSEDGE

- These types weeds can be found all year and can be difficult to control if the irrigation is not reduced.
- You may also notice these weeds in areas around downspouts, low areas that hold water, and compacted soils.



## CONTROL

- Reduce the amount of irrigation when brown patch or the above weeds are present. Be aware of seasonal budget adjustments.
- Chemical control, especially on aquatic weeds may require multiple applications and is very expensive even after the water is reduced. Being proactive is the best practice.
